Non-discrimination Policy

Trinity Lutheran School admits students of any sex, race, color, national and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school. It does not discriminate on the basis of sex, race, color, national and ethnic origin, political beliefs, or disabilities in administration of its educational policies, admissions policies, financial assistance policies, and athletic and other school-administered programs.

Admissions Policy

Trinity Lutheran School is open to children who are members of Trinity Lutheran Church as well as children who are not members of Trinity who are seeking a Christ-centered educational program and who subscribe to the philosophy and objectives as stated in the Handbook for Parents.

PROOF OF DATE OF BIRTH – Parents will need to supply the school with an original or certified copy of birth certificate. A hospital certificate will NOT be accepted. No student will be permitted to attend class without proof of date of birth.

KINDERGARTEN students must have reached the age of FIVE (5) on or before the first of September.

PROOF OF IMMUNIZATIONS: The parents must supply a complete immunization health record from a licensed physician. Immunizations must be current according to the Texas Department of Health requirements. A physician's statement indicating that the student has been examined in the last year and is able to participate in the school's program is also required.

Children in the Preschool, Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten programs are required to be potty trained. Those children in the MDO program need to be able to "toddle" – walk. This is for the safety of the children in case of emergencies and fire drills.

PRE-REGISTRATION – All families currently having children at Trinity Lutheran School and Trinity Lutheran Early Childhood will be given a chance to pre-register their children for the next year at a discounted registration rate.

Steps to Admission

1. Get acquainted and visit our school.
2. Submit your application online.
3. Submit all supplemental documentation (i.e birth certificate, immunization record, Health Statement. (Early Childhood), Report Card (Students enrolled in 1st-8th Grade)
4. When accepted, complete online enrollment and submit applicable registration fee.

ACCEPTANCE – Applications are accepted for new students in early February. Applications are reviewed in the order they are received. All required documents must be received prior to acceptance. Once students are accepted into our program, parents are invited to complete Online Enrollment. Placement in an open spot is based on the date of your completed Online Enrollment and payment of your registration fee. If an application is received and accepted for a class that is currently full, the student will be placed on a waiting list. Classroom placement is not reserved until the registration fee has been paid and Online Enrollment (separate from Online Application) is complete.
