

2nd Year Confirmation Faith Testimony

We pray that your confirmation journey has been one of spiritual growth and development. This project will give you a chance to identify when and how the Lord has been working in your life. Everyone has a faith testimony and each story reveals the faithfulness of God through the life events we encounter. Here are some guidelines that will help you process and write your faith journey.

FAITH TESTIMONY INSTRUCTIONS

DUE BY APRIL 10th

Step 1: Ask God to help you write this paper, not for us, or your parents, or your grandma, but for you! Make this paper a testimony of who God is in your life now and going forward.

Step 2: Describe your background:

Name – born where and when
Important family information

Step 3: List some childhood faith memories:

*Camps, memorable church services (describe your “young” faith)
*Spiritual influences (coaches, grandparents, parents, siblings)

Step 4: Choose a **main point** that has helped to define your faith:

A challenge that you had to overcome, or relationship struggles, or dealing with a loss that tested your faith us caused you to ask God big questions.

Step 5: Tell how these experiences have molded you into the person you are today:

How they have helped you identify your passion, gain empathy for the lost, learn how to trust God more, or given you the ability to talk boldly about your faith.

Step 6: In your own words, what does it mean to follow Jesus?

Include some Bible verses that are important to your faith walk.

The faith papers will be read by Pastor Lee. A few will be chosen to be shared publically at the confirmation rehearsal. (You will know beforehand if you have been chosen and may decline if you wish. We will ask people prior to April 15th if they are willing to share.) May the Lord bless your efforts and be glorified through your testimonies.
