

CONFIRMATION AT TRINITY KLEIN

The goal of Confirmation at Trinity Klein is for each student to be prepared and equipped to confirm their baptismal faith publicly by the conclusion of the confirmation journey.

Students will attain this goal as they take ownership of their confirmation journey by participating in and completing the following:

- **Launch Meeting Video**

Pastor Lee will release a video in August that explains the confirmation process. Parents and students are both asked to watch the video so that we are all in for the program together. A Q&A Zoom Webinar will be held after the release of the video in an effort to answer any questions from parents or students.

- **Confirmation Journals & Unit Check-Ins**

Students will each be given a confirmation journal that will consist of approximately ninety lessons broken down into eight units. Students wishing to complete the program in a year should aim to complete each unit in between Confirmation Church services.

We encourage students to share with their parents what they are learning along the way. This is a great opportunity to grow together! At times, the journal will even prompt students to share. What you put into the journey is what you will get out.

Each unit will begin with an opening video from Pastor Lee to introduce the unit and close with a video that will help guide each student's journey. At the conclusion of each unit, students will complete the "Unit Check-In" that will be sent to Pastor Lee, their parents, and a confirmation mentor.

Unit Check-Ins, videos, and other resources for your confirmation journals will be available at confirmation.trinityklein.org.

- **Confirmation Church**

Students will join with their families* once a month for what we will call "Confirmation Church" that will take place on eight Sundays throughout the year. Confirmation Church will consist of an hour-long worship service that is both experiential and focused on teaching connected to the previous unit in the journal. After the service, students will have thirty minutes with their confirmation groups. While students join their confirmation groups (led by confirmation mentors), parents will remain with pastor in the large room.

The focus of these services will be the confirmation journey and the Six Chief Parts of the Christian Faith. Confirmation Church will be in session from September to April. To complete the confirmation journey, students will attend all eight services of Confirmation Church.

* Should a student's parents be unable to attend regularly with the student, Trinity Klein will provide a confirmation sponsor for the duration of the student's journey.

- **Small Group Participation**

We highly value the involvement of a student in a small group setting. While we are not completely certain at this moment what that will look like for the fall, as soon as information is available on our small group opportunities, we will share that with our Confirmation families.

- **Confirmation Verse and Banner**

As a student nears the end of their confirmation journey, they will select a bible verse (or have one selected for them) that will serve as their confirmation verse. During this time, we will provide materials and instructions for the student to complete a confirmation banner that will be displayed during the confirmation service.

- **Celebration Interview**

Once a student has completed their Confirmation Journal they may set up a Celebration Interview where they will review their confirmation journey and finish their preparation to confirm their baptismal faith publicly. For those beginning the journey in August, interviews will take place in the Spring.

- **How will I receive communications about confirmation updates?**

- **How do I register?**

All students may be registered for the program at *confirmation.trinityklein.org*. There you will find one form for 7th and 8th grade students and one for high school students.

- The 7th/8th grade form will also enroll you for your small group participation and automatically enrolls you for the Jr. High Fall Retreat.
- The high school form will ask which small group participating option you will be choosing as well as some additional options for high school students. If you choose Sunday Night Crew as your small group option, you will need to register at *crew.trinityklein.org*.

- **What is the cost of the Confirmation program?**

For Jr. High students the cost of the program is \$100. This fee includes a catechism, banner supplies, robe rental, confirmation journal, and the Jr. High Retreat.

For high school students the cost of the program is \$60 with additional options that are explained on the registration form. This base cost covers catechism and confirmation journal.

- **What if I have younger children at Confirmation Church?**

Every member of the family is welcome to join us at Confirmation Church! While Pastor Lee is talking with parents and confirmation students are with their mentors, we will have high schoolers available to take non-confirmation siblings to the Elementary School Gym for some fun. We have also coordinated with the nursery at Trinity Klein to ensure they would remain open until the end of our time together—they are wonderful for that! Please just let us know how many we should be expecting in the nursery.

- **What if I didn't join in August?**

Please talk with Pastor Lee about the next opportunity to begin your confirmation journey.

- **How long do I have to complete the program?**

This program is designed to focus a student's efforts into a one-year journey. That being said, if a student does not complete their journey within two years' time, they will meet with Pastor Lee to discuss restarting the journey.

- **Acolyte Rotation**

All 7th and 8th graders are invited and encouraged to participate as acolytes in our regular worship services. This is a wonderful opportunity to serve alongside of God's people in His house. A Sign-Up Genius will become available at jrcrew.trinityklein.org for those students who wish to join the acolyte *rotation* for a given season (Sept-Dec, Jan-April, May-August) once acolytes return to the worship services at Trinity Klein. Additional sign-ups will be made available for special services and seasons (Thanksgiving, Advent, Christmas, Lent, Easter). Schedules for each season are made alphabetically. Students needing to switch dates once assigned must find their replacements. Priority for each rotation will be given to 8th grade students.

- **Life's Flight, TBD April 2021**

All 8th graders are welcomed to join us for our Life's Flight event where we take a "flight through life" from baptism to resurrection. More information available in the spring.

- **Jr. High Mission to Houston, TBD June 2021**
