

CREW STUDENT MINISTRY LIABILITY & PHOTO WAIVER STATEMENT

In consideration for being accepted by Trinity Lutheran Church for participation in Church sponsored trips and activities, we (I), being 21 years of age or older, do for ourselves (myself) (and for and on behalf of my child-participant if said child is not 21 years of age or older) do hereby release, forever discharge and agree to hold harmless Trinity Lutheran Church and directors thereof from any and all liability, claims or demands for personal injury, sickness or death, as well as property damage and expenses, of any nature whatsoever which may be incurred by the undersigned and the child-participant that occur while said child is participating in church sponsored trips or activities.

Furthermore, we (I) [and on behalf of our (my) child-participant if under the age of 21 years] hereby assume all risk of personal injury, sickness, death, damage and expense as a result of participation in recreation and work activities involved therein.

Further, authorization and permission is hereby given to said church to furnish any necessary transportation, food and lodging for this participant.

The undersigned further hereby agrees to hold harmless and indemnify said church, its directors, employees and agents, for any liability sustained by said church as the result of the negligent, willful or intentional acts of said participant, including expenses incurred attendant thereto.

We (I) authorize an adult, in whose care the minor has been entrusted, to consent to any X-ray examination, anesthetic, medical, surgical or dental diagnosis or treatment, and hospital care, to be rendered to the minor under the general or special supervision and on the advice of any physician or dentist licensed under the provisions of the Medical Practice Act on the medical staff of a licensed hospital, whether such diagnosis or treatment is rendered at the office of said physician or at said hospital.

The undersigned shall be liable and agrees to pay all costs and expenses incurred in connection with such medical and dental services rendered to our (my) child pursuant to this authorization.

Should it be necessary for our (my) child to return home due to medical reasons or otherwise, the undersigned shall assume all transportation costs.

The undersigned does also hereby give permission for our (my) child to return home due to medical reasons or otherwise, the undersigned shall assume all transportation costs.

The undersigned does also hereby give permission for our (my) child to ride in any vehicle designated by the adult in whose care the minor has been entrusted while attending and participating in activities sponsored by Trinity Lutheran Church.

CREW STUDENT MINISTRY COVID-19 LIABILITY WAIVER STATEMENT

I understand that during this COVID -19 Pandemic I will NOT be permitted to enter the facility beyond the designated drop-off and pick-up area as a non-volunteer parent. I understand that this procedure change is for the safety of all persons present in the facility and to limit the possible risk of exposure. I understand that it is my responsibility to inform any Emergency Contact persons of the information contained herein.

I understand that IF there is an emergency requiring me to enter the facility beyond the designated drop-off and pick-up area, I MUST wash my hands before entering and wear a mask.

I understand that to attend Trinity Klein Student Ministry activities my child must be free from COVID-19 symptoms. If, at any time, any of the following symptoms appear my child will be separated from the rest of the people in the activity. I will be contacted, and my child MUST be picked up from the facility within 30 minutes of being notified. Symptoms include, *Fever of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher *Signs of respiratory infection *Dry cough *Shortness of breath *Chills *Loss of taste or smell *Sore throat *Muscle aches. While we understand that many of these symptoms can also be related to non-COVID-19 related issues we must proceed with an abundance of caution during this pandemic. My child will need to be symptom free without medication for 72 hours before returning to campus.

I understand that my child will be required to wash their hands using CDC recommended hand washing procedures throughout their time on campus using warm running water and rubbing with soap for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water is not available, I understand that hand sanitizer of 60% or more alcohol content will be used.

I will immediately notify Trinity Klein's Student Ministry Pastor, Lee Hopf, if I become aware of any person whom my child or I have had contact with exhibits any of the symptoms listed in paragraph 3, is advised to self-isolate, quarantine, or has tested positive, or is presumed positive for COVID-19.

I understand that while outside of Trinity Klein Lutheran Church (TKLC), I will follow the recommendations from the CDC, state and local government in order to help protect all those my child will come in contact with while at TKLC.

I understand that while present at TKLC my child will be in contact with children, families and other employees who are also at risk of community exposure. I understand that no list of restrictions, guidelines or practices will remove 100% of the risk of exposure to COVID-19 as the virus can be transmitted by persons who are asymptomatic and before some people show signs of infection. I understand that I play a crucial role in keeping everyone at TKLC safe and reducing the risk of exposure by following the practices outlined herein and that Trinity Klein Lutheran Church and School is in no way responsible if my child is exposed or becomes ill.

I certify that I have read, understand, and agree to comply with the provisions listed herein. I acknowledge that failure to act in accordance with the provisions listed or with any other policy or procedure outlined by TKLC will result in termination of services. I acknowledge that care for my child will be terminated if it is determined that my actions, or lack of action unnecessarily exposes another employee, child, or their family to COVID-19.
